RMR-Rocky Mountain Region

- Whiteout is a member of USA Volleyball and plays in the Rocky Mountain Region (RMR)
- RMR is the organization that governs the tournaments in Colorado. The region consists of teams from Colorado and Wyoming.
- Teams are divided by age with September 1st being the cut off date between divisions.
- Player may play up a division, but not down.

Age Divisions

- 17s – Players born on or after September 1, 2001
- 16s – Players born on or after September 1, 2002
- 15s – Players born on or after September 1, 2003
- 14s – Players born on or after September 1, 2004
- 13s – Players born on or after September 1, 2005
- 12s – Players born on or after September 1, 2006
