RMR-Rocky Mountain Region

- Whiteout is a member of USA Volleyball and plays in the Rocky Mountain Region (RMR)
- RMR is the organization that governs the tournaments in Colorado. The region consists of teams from Colorado and Wyoming.
- Teams are divided by age with September 1st being the cut off date between divisions.
- Player may play up a division, but not down.

Crossroads is designated a “stay to play” tournament. Teams are required by the tournament to purchase hotel rooms as part of registration.

All athletes who participate in Crossroads are required to stay in the team hotel with their teammates and coach. The fees are included in dues. **This is mandatory; no athletes will be exempt.** This will be fun and encourage team camaraderie. Many sports organize travel like this; this is not a fresh idea. *Please do not ask if your daughter can stay elsewhere.*

Parents are welcome to stay at the same hotel or at the lodging of their choice. Select parents can have “on duty” shifts to chaperone girls when coaches are “off”. *More details to come.*
