14s: Players who were born on or after July 1, 2007

13s: Players who were born on or after July 1, 2008

12s: Players who were born on or after July 1, 2009

Health & Safety

What You Need to Tryout:

- **RMR Membership:** Registration link on website with detailed instructions.
- **Proof of Age:** COPY of your birth certificate, passport or driver's license
- **Team Placement Contract**

If your child is NOT placed on a team, the \$50 tryout fee will be refunded.

Code of Conduct

- **Take Responsibility** - earn respect by owning mistakes and being willing to change.

Communication

- Each team needs a team parent to organize select travel arrangements, snack rotations, and so on. If you'd like to volunteer, please email Val.
- During the season if concerns arise, please encourage your athlete to approach their coach. Let's empower these young women to communicate for themselves.
- Only after this attempt, if a solution is not found, Angelica can be contacted by an athlete or parent.
- Ultimately the board of directors is available if all previous steps haven't lead to a solution.

Season Dues

Option 2 - Payment Plan (3 payments)

- February 1

We must receive all 3 checks upfront for Option 2 or you must use credit card online.

Unpaid dues means athletes do not play.

Scholarships

Stay to Play

“Stay to play” tournaments are where teams are **required by the tournament** to purchase hotel rooms as part of registration.

Athletes are required to stay in the team hotel with their teammates and coach. **The fees are included in dues. This is mandatory; no athletes will be exempt.** This will be fun and encourage team camaraderie. Many sports organize travel like this; this is not a fresh idea. *Please do not ask if your daughter can stay elsewhere.*

Parents are welcome to stay at the same hotel or at the lodging of their choice. Team Parents will also be provided a room by the club to be the main designated chaperone. Parents will have “on duty” shifts to chaperone girls when coaches are “off”. *More details to come.*
